### What is it?

### Where can I get an application?

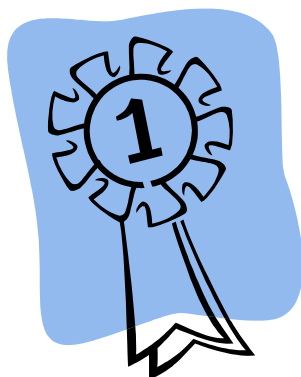
